The University should serve as a living example of the historic mission and priorities of the state of Nebraska and its community. The University must foster an intellectually stimulating, culturally stimulating, and safe and secure environment for its students, faculty, staff, and visitors. The University must give full recognition to the dignity of the human person in all aspects of education and research. The University must become a major national, regional, and international center for the teaching of science, the sciences, and the humanities. The University must provide the highest quality educational opportunities and research facilities for faculty and students. The University must serve the public good and the State of Nebraska by providing a superior education to its citizens and employees and by making important contributions to the advancement of society. The University must use its unique positions in the community to speak out against injustice and seek the full dignity and rights of all people. The University must operate for the common good and the general welfare and encourage loyalty to the common good. The University must support the free and unfettered pursuit of truth and its attainment by each member of the University community. The University must be managed to ensure that it is managed for the common good. The University must demonstrate exemplary adherence to the doctrines of the Christian religion and the ethical and moral principles as stated in the Nebraska Constitution. The University should be a source of the highest quality and integrity of scholarship, teaching, and research, and should provide the means by which the University of Nebraska will make a significant and enduring contribution to society. The University must be prepared to serve as a national and international model for the fulfillment of the University's purposes. The University should be committed to and serve as a living demonstration of the values, principles, and ethics which represent the best traditions of the state of Nebraska and the University. These standards have not always been met and will not always be.
